Thank you for your letter of 20 January 2020 and the complaint raised with us by Mr Roy.

### **The ICO's role**

Part of our role is to consider complaints from individuals who believe their data protection rights have been infringed. We want to improve the way organisations deal with the personal information they are responsible for.

### **Our view**

I have considered the information available in relation to this complaint and I am of the view that Derby Road Fund Committee (DRFC) did not breach the data protection regulations in providing a list of addresses to a local estate agents office. This is because individuals could not be identified from the information provided.

However, in my view, while I understand any potential buyers would need to be aware of this information, it was not necessary to proactively provide addresses to an estate agent. On this basis, we would like you to consider carefully the information you release to third parties in future to ensure you do not disclose the personal data of residents to others.

We are not going to take any further action in this case, but we will keep a record of all the complaints raised with us about the way you process personal information.
